AMENDED ARTICLES OF COOPERATION OF

Davao BIR Employees Multipurpose Cooperative (DABIREMCO)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

We, the undersigned Filipino citizens, all of legal age and residents of the Philippines, with a firm collective intent, have come together to organize voluntarily a **Primary Multipurpose** Cooperative to advance what we believe is our inherent right, under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

AND WHEREBY CERTIFY:

ARTICLE I NAME OF COOPERATIVE

That the name of this cooperative shall be <u>DAVAO BIR EMPLOYEES</u> <u>MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE (DABIREMCO).</u>

ARTICLE II PURPOSE/S

That the purposes for which this cooperative is organized are to engage in:

- 1. To generate funds and grant loans to its members for providential and productive purposes;
- 2. To engage in the business of providing educational services and as learning service provider (LSP) to its members and non-members.
- 3. To engage in the business of providing photocopying services to its members and non-members;
- 4. To engage in buying and selling of food and non-food products to its members and non-members;
- 5. To operate a canteen and catering services open to members and non-members;
- 6. To accept interest-bearing savings and time deposit from members;
- 7. To engage in the business of travel and tour services, bills payment and remittance center, subject to existing government rules and regulations;
- 8. To engage in selling of cellphone loads; and
- 9. To engage in buying, developing and selling of real properties including memorial lots. Subject to existing government rules and regulations.

ARTICLE III GOALS

That the goals of this cooperative are to help improve the quality of life of its members and thereby contribute to inclusive growth, enterprise development and employment. In furtherance thereto, it shall aim:

- 1. To promote and advocate cooperativism among its members and the public through socially oriented projects, education and training, research and communication and other similar activities to reach out to its intended beneficiaries;
- 2. To promote and advance the economic and social status of the members;
- 3. To attain increased income, savings, investments, productivity and purchasing power, and to promote among themselves equitable distribution of net surplus through maximum utilization of economies of scale, cost-sharing and risk-sharing;
- 4. To provide optimum social and economic benefits to its members;
- 5. To teach members efficient ways of doing things in cooperative manner;
- 6. To propagate cooperative practices and new ideas in business and management;
- 7. To allow the lower income group and less privileged groups to increase their ownership in the wealth of the nation;
- 8. To actively support the government, other cooperatives and people-oriented organizations, both local and foreign, in promoting cooperatives as a practical means towards sustainable socio-economic development under a truly just and democratic society;
- 9. To institutionalize a dynamic savings mobilization and capital build-up schemes to sustain its developmental activities and long-term investments, thereby insuring optimum economic benefits to the members, their families and the general public;
- 10. To implement policy guidelines that will ensure transparency, equitable access to its resources and services, and promote the interests of the members;
- 11. To provide goods and services and other requirements to the members;
- 12. To develop expertise and skills among its members;
- 13. To encourage thrift and savings mobilization among the members;
- 14. To encourage and promote self-help or self-employment as an engine for economic growth and poverty alleviation; and
- 15. To provide goods and services to its members to enable them to attain increased income, savings, investments, productivity and purchasing power, and promote among themselves equitable distribution of net surplus through maximum utilization of economies of scale, cost-sharing and risk-

sharing; and

16. To adopt such other plans as may help foster the welfare of the members, their families and the community.

ARTICLE IV POWERS AND CAPACITIES

That the powers, rights and capacities of this cooperative shall have the following powers, rights and capacities as prescribed under Article 9 of Republic Act 9520:

- 1. To the exclusive use of its registered name;
- 2. To sue and be sued;
- 3. Of succession;
- 4. To amend its Articles of Cooperation in accordance with the provisions of RA 9520;
- 5. To adopt the by-laws not contrary to law, morals or public policy, and to amend and repeal the same in accordance with RA 9520;
- 6. To purchase, receive, take or grant, hold, convey, sell, lease, pledge, mortgage, and otherwise deal with such real and personal property as the transaction of the lawful affairs of the cooperative may reasonably and necessarily require, subject to the limitations prescribed by law and the Constitution;
- 7. To enter into division, merger, or consolidation, as provided under RA 9520;
- 8. To form subsidiary cooperatives and join federations or unions, as provided under RA 9520;
- 9. To avail of loans, be entitled to credit and to accept and receive grants, donations and assistance from foreign and domestic sources subject to the conditions of said loans, credits, grants, donations or assistance that will not undermine the autonomy of the cooperative. The Authority, upon written request, shall provide necessary assistance in the documentary requirements for the loans, credit, grants, donations and other financial support;
- 10.To avail preferential rights granted to Cooperatives under RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, and other laws;
- 11. To exercise such other powers granted under RA 9520 or necessary to carry out its purposes as stated in this Articles of Cooperation.

ARTICLE V TERM OF EXISTENCE

That the term for which this Cooperative shall exist is **Fifty (50)** years from the date of its registration with the Cooperative Development Authority.

ARTICLE VI COMMON BOND AND FIELD OF MEMBERSHIP

That the common bond of membership of this Cooperative is **Residential** and, shall be open to all natural persons who are **employees of the Bureau of Internal Revenue Region No. 19, Davao City and the regular employees of this cooperative**, all Filipino citizens, of legal age, with the capacity to contract and possess all the qualifications and none of the disqualifications provided for in the Bylaws and this Articles of Cooperation. That **an employee who became a member and later on retires from the service/employment or transferred to another office/ region shall continue the membership if one maintains the responsibilities as a regular member, otherwise, the said member shall be classified as associate member.**

ARTICLE VII AREA OF OPERATION

That the membership of this Cooperative shall <u>originally come from BIR</u>

<u>Davao - Revenue Region.</u> Its principal office shall be located at <u>BIR Regional Office</u>,

<u>BIR Bldg.</u>, <u>Bolton Extension</u>, <u>Davao City</u>.

- b. **Ten Thousand (10,000)** preferred shares with a par value of **Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00)** per share.

ARTICLE XI SUBSCRIBED AND PAID-UP SHARE CAPITAL

That of the authorized share capital, in the amount of <u>Thirty-two Million Nine Hundred Seventy-four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php32,974,500.00)</u> has been subscribed and <u>Twenty-five Million Eight Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php25,878,500.00)</u> of the total subscription has been paid by the following members-subscribers: (Please see attached Annex "A")

ARTICLE XII ARBITRAL CLAUSE

Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Articles of Cooperation, By-laws, the Cooperative laws and related rules, administrative guidelines of the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), including inter-cooperative, interfederation disputes and related concerns shall be exclusively referred to and finally resolved by voluntary arbitration under the institutional rules promulgated by the Cooperative Development Authority(CDA), after compliance with the conciliation or mediation mechanisms embodied in the applicable By-laws and in such other pertinent laws and issuances.

BE IT KNOWN THAT:

MS. LUZ C. ALBARACIN has been elected as Treasurer of this Cooperative to act as such until **the** successor shall have been duly appointed and qualified accordance

with the By-laws. As such, **the Treasurer**, has been authorized to receive payments and issue receipts for membership fees, share capital subscriptions and other revenues, and to pay obligations for and in the name of cooperative.
